Other Highlights

- Ben Jukich became the first DWU baseball player to be selected in the Major League Baseball draft in 2006. Jukich was selected in the 13th round (398th overall) by the Oakland A's. He also became the first GPAC player to be chosen in the MLB Draft. Jukich was traded to the Cincinnati Reds organization on June 12, 2007. In 2008, Jukich was named the Reds Minor League Pitcher-of-the-Month in May, and he started the Southern League (Double-A) All-Star game, earning the win with one perfect inning. He was promoted to the Reds Triple-A affiliate, the Louisville Bats, during the 2008 season. In 2009, he has pitched both as a starter and a reliever for the Bats, with the major leagues just one step away.
- Dakota Wesleyan University defeated an NCAA Division I school, the University of North Dakota, in a nine-inning game on April 15, 2009, in Fargo, N.D. The Tigers trailed 14-6 after six innings, but they scored 12 unanswered runs in the final three frames to earn the historic, come-from-behind win.
- The Tigers' 2009 GPAC Postseason Tournament Championship earned DWU its first bid in the NAIA Baseball National Tournament opening round. DWU went 0-2 at the national tournament opening round in St. Charles, Mo.
